ENERGY SAVING INITIATIVES

Over the last 10 years we have invested heavily in energy saving measures as our gas, water and electricity bills were enormous. So far we have installed a pool cover to keep the pool warm at night, sensor operated low energy lighting, a state of the art air sourced heat pump and solar panels on the roof to name a few. We are also planning to replace the lighting around the building with LED based units which should help to reduce our bills even further in future years. Our aim is to eventually produce more electricity on site than we use by the installation of further solar panels on the roof.

A REMINDER TO ALL CENTRE USERS

Please can we ask all centre users to adhere to the 5 mile hour speed limit on entering and leaving the car park.

We should also like to remind users that the car park is only for your use whilst you are in the centre. We have busy periods and require all the parking spaces for those using the centre.
